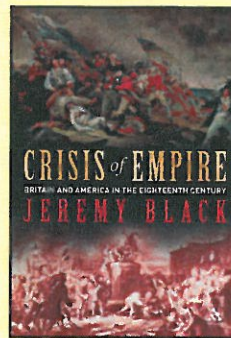

This new work demonstrates how the outcome of the First World War has formed the modern world we live in today.

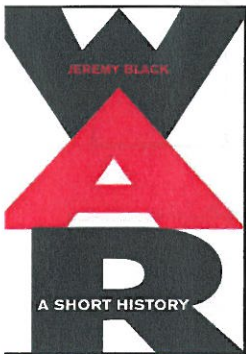
